

- 1. I am vegan/vegetarian. Will the lunch provided for volunteers accommodate food restrictions?
 - a. Yes. Please indicate your dietary restrictions on the Volunteer form.
- 2. I know a K-12 student who would like to attend the event (not volunteer). Can they sign-up to participate?
 - a. Yes. Please contact <u>president@csulbasce.org</u>. K-12 students attending the Dream Big event are organized and assigned by the CSULB K-12 Outreach and Recruitment not ASCE CSULB. Waivers and photo release forms are handled by their team.
 - b. Teachers/Parents/Guardians must be present to accompany the additional K-12 students at the event. Transportation to the CSULB campus must also be coordinated independently. School buses for the students are not funded by the event host.
- 3. I found out about the event on social media and are not affiliated with a specific professional group or student chapter. Can I still volunteer?
 - a. Yes. Everyone interested in volunteering are welcome to participate. Specifying a professional group or student chapter on the Volunteer Form is simply to help organize groups already assigned to host specific workshops.

4. I registered to volunteer; how do I find out which workshop I am assigned to?

a. Volunteer assignments will be shared within a week of the Dream Big event to all registered volunteers by ASCE CSULB. If you are a part of a professional group or a student chapter and are already assigned to a workshop, please check with your lead what workshop you will be involved in. Otherwise, please wait to receive an email notification for more information.

5. I registered as a Professional volunteer; why do I need to indicate my civil engineering/public works discipline?

a. Since Dream Big workshops are created to promote the various civil engineering/public works disciplines, Professional Volunteer assignments may be based on the discipline you currently work in to provide the real-world perspective of the workshop to K-12 students. However, depending on the range of the number of volunteers by discipline we receive, you may or may not be assigned to your specific discipline. This information is not a requirement on the Volunteer Form.

6. It is my first time at the CSULB Campus, where do I park?

a. Parking instructions to the CSULB campus will be provided within a week of the Dream Big event to all registered volunteers by ASCE CSULB.

7. I registered to volunteer; do I have to stay the whole day (7:00 am to 1:00 pm)?

- a. No. Although we highly encourage you to stay for the whole event, registered volunteers may leave after the 3rd workshop (10:35 am), or after lunch (11:00 am). We simply ask that you indicate your early departure on the *"Are there any other comments or suggestions you'd like to make?"* section of the Volunteer Form.
- b. If you are assigned as a panelist and are not volunteering for the workshops, your shift is at 11:10 am 12:00 pm, and do not need to arrive at 7:00 am for Volunteer Check-In. Please check the specific instructions sent to your email for more information.

8. I registered as a volunteer; I can no longer attend.

a. Please notify ASCE CSULB at <u>president@csulbasce.org</u> as soon as possible.

9. I registered as a volunteer; is it possible to watch the ASCE Dream Big film with the students?

a. Yes. There will be two simultaneous streaming of the film during the event. Feel free to stay and watch! Please check the master schedule for the times and location (i.e., room number).
